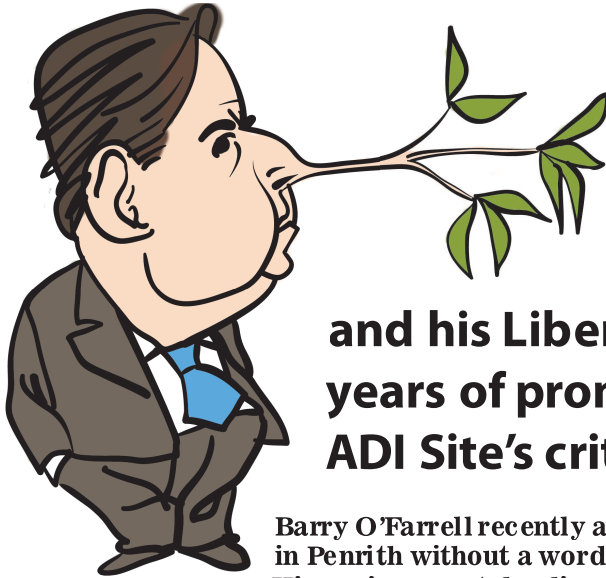


What sort of honest government will the Liberal/Nationals deliver when they are prepared to sweep eight years of promises to the people of Western Sydney under the carpet?
